The purpose of this letter is to transmit a copy of a Resolution calling for the repeal of HB2.

The AAUW NC state organization held its annual meeting on April 2, 2016. Each year, we discuss public policy issues of interest to our members and adopt a legislative agenda. The passage of HB 2 (now S.L.2016-3) was of great interest due to its potential negative impact on the citizens of North Carolina and the responses of the corporate world and other governments to its passage.

Following discussion, the members approved a resolution calling on the General Assembly to repeal HB2 when the 2016 session begins on April 25th. A copy of this resolution is attached. Copies are also being sent to local governments and members of the General Assembly.
