Directions to the hotel:

From the WEST: From I-40 E, follow directions to the PTI Airport and Bryan Blvd. Follow Bryan Blvd. to Benjamin Pkwy., which merges onto Battleground Ave. Go straight and turn right on Greene St. The hotel is straight ahead on the left.

From the EAST: From I-40 W, take Exit #227 for I-840 to US-70 toward Greensboro. At the end of the exit ramp, turn right onto US-70/Wendover Ave. Exit onto Elm St. South (toward downtown to your left). Turn right on Lindsey St. The hotel is on your right.

Rooms: The discounted AAUW NC rate for a standard room (2 doubles or king) is \$125 plus tax. The deadline for discounted group rate reservations is **March 3**. Questions regarding room arrangements should be directed to Sonya Dukes at the hotel.

Parking: For overnight AAUW guests, parking is complimentary. Daily parking for AAUW guests is discounted to \$2 per car, per day.
