2020 Centennial Women's History Bus Trip



Overview

The AAUW NC 2020 Centennial Committee announces a bus trip to visit the Seneca Falls, NY museums and homes of women who worked on the Suffrage movement in 1848. The bus trip departs Greensboro, NC at 6 AM on Friday, May 1st, headed to Seneca Falls/Rochester NY and returns very late (approximately 10 PM) Sunday, May 3rd, with other women's history stops along the way.

Prices

- Single room per person \$738.00
- Double room per person \$492.00

Non-member Note: There is a \$50 surcharge for those who are not AAUW members or you can join AAUW at the National level for \$59 for 12 months (see bus registration form for info). You need at least an associate or equivalent degree to join.

Member Note: An AAUW member on the trip may sponsor one nonmember and have the surcharge waived (see below).

Key Reminders - May 2020 NC Bus Tour to Seneca Falls

To register for the tour you must check a box that says you have read and understood these restrictions on the tour. Any updates/changes will be sent to those registered in email and posted on the website.

- 1. The Fee is per person and includes bus trip, 2 hotel nights (different hotels) with breakfast, tickets to sites, driver gratuity, water on bus, bus entertainment, processing fees.
- 2. Each person pays their own lunches, snacks and dinners.
- 3. Trip is only open to ages 15 and up. Anyone under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 4. Full payment is required to hold a reservation. Refunds are available until February 15. Registrants are encouraged to consider purchasing trip insurance.
- 5. Register online at aauwnc.org. When you click SUBMIT on the last page of the registration form you will be transferred to PayPal where you can pay online with a credit card or PayPal account. To pay by check, make it payable to AAUW NC, put "bus trip" on the memo line, and send it to AAUW NC Treasurer Wendy Haner, 5 Kimberly Avenue, Asheville, NC 28804.
- 6. If there are fewer than 45 reservations for the tour by **Midnight February 21**, the trip will be cancelled and full refunds issued. **Note: The Asheville departure has been cancelled.**
- 7. Registration will close when the bus is full (52 paid registrations).
- 8. All participants are expected to manage their own luggage transfers from the bus to the hotel and vice versa. Each passenger is allowed one piece of luggage, with a limit of 70 pounds for all items including suitcase, purse, etc.
- 9. The tour is on a very tight schedule. All participants are expected to be at the pickup points at the times specified. The trip will include climbing stairs on the bus and at some of the places we visit.
- 10. If you are registering for the "double" rate, you are responsible for finding your roommate.
- 11. AAUW members may offer the member rate to one (1) other person who will be accompanying them. Members will be asked for their Member ID and Primary branch when registering at the member rate. A nonmember sponsored by a member will be asked for the member's Name, AAUW Member ID, and Primary Branch.
