#### **Community Hub and Other National Supported Items**

- Revised the AAUW NC log of open connect@aauw.org help requests (Angie Cooper). 18 records being tracked.
- Scheduled a Zoom meeting on November 26th with Angie Cooper to discuss the open help requests. Status requests have been unanswered for awhile.
   12 of the 18 to be discussed with Angie. Two important ones include:
  - Fellowships and Grants
    - The Fellowships and Grants team is no longer utilizing our previous F&G Directory and the awardees currently listed only go up to the 22-23 award year. Similar to the MSD, the directory was designed and updated by a staff member who has since retired and it is unable to be maintained in its previous format. Since migrating all fellowship and grants data to Nimble/Community Hub, a similar directory in this system was explored. In the end, it was determined that building out such a directory in our current system was not feasible.
    - The National staff are working on a request form for sponsorship information for recent fellows and grantees. Ahead of that new form requests for information can be emailed to fellowships@aauw.org. Please allow for a 2 week timeframe to request information. Information that can be requested includes what was shared online in the previous directory. Those requesting information should be limited to state and branch leaders as well as donors who have established endowed funds.
